**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MONTHLY HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION & BULLYING REPORT
 FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2017
 PURSUANT TO BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY 5512**

WHEREAS, the Springfield Township Board of Education believes that a safe and civil environment in school is necessary for students to learn and achieve high academic standards. Since students learn by example, school administrators, faculty, staff, and volunteers are required to demonstrate appropriate

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131 behavior, treating others with civility and respect, and refusing to tolerate harassment, intimidation or
 132 bullying. Harassment, intimidation or bullying, like other disruptive or violent behaviors, is conduct that
 133 disrupts both a student's ability to learn and a school's ability to educate its students in a safe
 134 environment. Therefore, the school district will not tolerate acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying;
 135 and

 137 **WHEREAS,** harassment, intimidation or bullying is defined as any gesture, any written, verbal or
 138 physical act, or any electronic communication, whether it be a single incident or a series of incidents, that
 139 is reasonably perceived as being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristic, such as race,
 140 color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a
 141 mental, physical or sensory disability, or by any other distinguishing characteristic, that takes place on
 142 school grounds, at any school-sponsored function or on a school bus, or off school grounds, in
 143 accordance with law, that substantially disrupts or interferes with the orderly operation of the school or the
 144 rights of other students, and that:

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 146 A reasonable person should know, under the circumstances, will have the effect of physically or
 147 emotionally harming a student or damaging the students property, or placing a student in reasonable fear
 148 of physical or emotional harm to his/her person or damage to his/her property; or has the effect of
 149 insulting or demeaning any student or group of students; or creates a hostile educational environment for
 150 the student by interfering with the students education or by severely or pervasively causing physical or
 151 emotional harm to the student; and

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 153 **WHEREAS,** the results of each investigation shall be reported to the board of education no later than
 154 the date of the next board meeting following the completion of the investigation, and include:

- 156 1. Any services provided;
- 157 2. Training established;
- 158 3. Discipline imposed; or
- 159 4. Other action taken or recommended by the chief school administrator; and
